Beyond the allotted time, interest will be charged at a rate of 1.5%, which is equivalent to 19.6% per annum (APR).

Funding

For your convenience, we offer two funding options when prepaying services or supplies. When prepaying, you pay for the services and supplies today and the money along with the accrued interest will be used to pay for the services and supplies when they are delivered at the time of death.

- Trust: You may pay the money directly to us and we will place it "In Trust", where it will accrue interest until the contract is fulfilled (when the services and supplies are delivered) or refunded (in part) if the contract is cancelled.
- **Insurance**: You may purchase an annuity through an insurance provider that over time will grow tax free and the proceeds will be paid to the funeral home to pay for the services or supplies at the time they are delivered or refunded (in part) if the contract is cancelled.

Suggestions of where funds may come from are; personal accounts, life insurance, retirement funds, investments, sale of real estate or other items, work benefits and/or insurance and possibility of a lump sum payment from Canada Pension Plan (CPP Death Benefit – which is a maximum \$2,500).

If there are concerns about finances there may be the availability of subsidies such as Last Post Fund or Social Services-Discretionary Benefits.
